

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS - 2012 KREPPNER AWARDS

Purpose and Description

In recognition of the breadth and depth of the late **James Kreppner**'s contributions in both the public and private domains, the HIV & AIDS Legal Clinic Ontario (HALCO) established the annual **Kreppner Awards** in 2010. The awards were created to recognize unparalleled achievement in advocating on behalf of or bettering the lives of people living with HIV or people co-infected with HIV and Hepatitis C.

Up to two awards may be given every year. One award may be given in recognition of outstanding accomplishment in the public domain. The other may be given in recognition of outstanding accomplishment that would otherwise be unheralded or would be considered as more in the private domain – i.e. an “unsung hero.”

Eligibility

Anyone who was employed by, volunteered or held office with, donated to, or received remuneration from HALCO within two years prior to HALCO's 2012 annual general meeting (to be held in September 2012) is not eligible to be considered for a **Kreppner Award** in 2012.

All nominations will be kept confidential. Candidates selected for an award will be notified by HALCO, and if the award is accepted, the winners will be announced at HALCO's 2012 Annual General Meeting.

Nominations

Nominations should explain in detail the contributions and accomplishments of the person being nominated. A committee appointed by HALCO's Board of Directors will review the nominations and make a recommendation to HALCO's Board of Directors.

The deadline for nominations is June 30, 2012. Late submissions will not be accepted.

Nominations must include the name and contact information of the person making the nomination. Nominations may be printed, written or typed and delivered by hand, mail, courier, FAX or electronically to HALCO, at:
